- This year's Australia Day Pioneer Women's Ceremony, with the Lord Mayor, the Hon. Sally Capp as guest speaker, was held at the Women's Peace Garden, Kensington, a beautiful place for such a ceremony.
- The 2018 annual My Vote My Voice event at Parliament House was on 31st August with the theme: "Diversity in Community Organisations" was most successful and had a diverse group of schools and students. This public speaking event for school students, which aims to promote the empowerment of young women, is gaining popularity and is highly regarded by schools. The 2019 My Vote My Voice event will be on 19th August. This year's theme is "Male and Female Youth as Future Voters".
- The May Forum "Sustainable safe cities, especially for women and girls, focusing on safe streets" was very well received.

We look forward to seeing you at the Annual General Meeting on Thursday 5th September, 12:00 for 12.15pm start at Level 4 Ross House, 247 Flinders Lane, Melbourne. Refreshments will be available.
