'Furious kickback against equality' must end, UN chief tells women activists as conference adopts landmark declaration. "A surge in misogyny, and a furious kickback against equality, threaten to slam on the brakes, and push progress into reverse."

"Let me be clear: This is unacceptable, immoral, and self-defeating. We must stop it – and we must stop it together." The UN Chief secretary said.
