This is an invitation from the National Council of Women of Victoria (NCWV) for your students to take part in our annual *My Vote My Voice* event and to make a brief presentation in the Legislative Council Chamber, Parliament of Victoria on the morning of **Monday 7**th **August 2023**.

This year's theme is *My Vote My Voice: What are the barriers to Human Rights in Australia? How can we begin to overcome them.* Students may carry out research, and gain insights from their peers and others to inform their views on the theme. Students are invited to make a **group presentation** of their findings in the Legislative Council Chamber.

Part of their research could include investigating jurisdictions who have, or are in the process of developing, a Human Rights Charter and how appropriate they are. The United Nations and Victoria already have a Human Rights Charter and there are moves to create an Australian Charter of Human Rights and Freedoms.

Although places are limited, we would welcome up to six students from your school (male and female in co-educational schools), with no more than **three** to be in the group presentation, with accompanying staff and parents welcome to attend.

We have arranged the program with photographs commencing at 9.15am in the Queen's Hall, an initial welcome, then students and guests will move to the Legislative Council Chamber for a program of speeches, student presentations and panel comments that will conclude at 12:30pm. There will be a refreshment break at 10:30am.

My Vote My Voice 2023 has the support of the President of the Legislative Council, and the Education and Community Engagement Unit, Parliament of Victoria; Australian Local Government Women's Association (Victoria); the League of Women Voters Victoria's Bessie Rischbieth Trust and the Victorian Electoral Commission.

The young members of NCWV – YoungNCWVic, are keen to hear from students who may be interested in joining this group. Some of the YoungNCWVic members are past speakers at this event.
